1. Scope

The successful bidder shall be responsible for the following:

1.1 Supply and Installation

- Installation of **fifteen (15) Cat6 network points**.
- All installations must include:
 - Structured cabling (Cat6 compliant)
 - Trunking
 - Termination
 - Labelling
 - Patch panel connections (where applicable)

1.2 Network Equipment

- Supply and configure **one (1) 24-port PoE network switch** with the following minimum specifications:
 - 24 x Gigabit Ethernet ports
 - Power over Ethernet (PoE/PoE+) capability
 - Managed switch (Layer 2 minimum)
 - Suitable for enterprise environment
 - Minimum 1-year warranty

1.3 Standards and Compliance

- All installations must comply with **recognised industry standards**, including:
 - TIA/EIA standards for structured cabling
 - ISO/IEC standards
 - Applicable South African National Standards (SANS)
- All materials used must be **new, unused, and of high quality**.

1.4 Testing and Certification

The service provider must:

- Test all installed network points using appropriate certification equipment.
- Provide **certified test results**.
- Ensure all points are fully functional and compliant.

1.5 Documentation and Handover

Upon completion, the service provider must provide:

- Network layout diagram
- Labelling schedule
- Test certification reports

- Equipment warranty documentation
- Final installation report

1.6 Installation and Completion Timeframes

- The bidder must indicate:
 - Delivery lead time
 - Installation duration
- The project must be completed within the agreed timeframe after the issuance of a purchase order.

1.7 Site Conditions

- Bidders must familiarise themselves with the site conditions.
- SACPCMP reserves the right to arrange a **site inspection**, where necessary.

1.8 Quality Assurance

- The service provider must implement adequate **quality control measures**.
- Any defects must be corrected at no additional cost.

3.5 The terms of the accompanying bid have not been, and will not be, disclosed by the bidder, directly or indirectly, to any competitor, prior to the date and time of the official bid opening or of the awarding of the contract.

3.6 There have been no consultations, communications, agreements or arrangements made by the bidder with any official of the procuring institution in relation to this procurement process prior to and during the bidding process except to provide clarification on the bid submitted where so required by the institution; and the bidder was not involved in the drafting of the specifications or terms of reference for this bid.

3.7 I am aware that, in addition and without prejudice to any other remedy provided to combat any restrictive practices related to bids and contracts, bids that are suspicious will be reported to the Competition Commission for investigation and possible imposition of administrative penalties in terms of section 59 of the Competition Act No 89 of 1998 and or may be reported to the National Prosecuting Authority (NPA) for criminal investigation and or may be restricted from conducting business with the public sector for a period not exceeding ten (10) years in terms of the Prevention and Combating of Corrupt Activities Act No 12 of 2004 or any other applicable legislation.

1. GENERAL CONDITIONS

- 1.1 The following preference point systems are applicable to all bids/ Quotations:

- 1.2 The value of this bid cannot exceed an estimated amount of R50 000 000 (including all applicable taxes) and therefore the 80/20 preferential procurement point system shall be applicable.

1.7 Tenderer failing to submit proof of required evidence to claim preferences for other specified goals, may only score in terms of the 80 or 90 points for price; and scores points out of 20 or 10 points, the relating to specific goals stated in the invitation to submit a tender

1.8 The purchaser reserves the right to require of a bidder, either before a bid is adjudicated or at any time subsequently, to substantiate any claim deemed fit in any manner required by the purchaser.

2. DEFINITIONS

People with disabilities”.	In terms of the Code of Good Practice on the Employment of Persons with disabilities: it is persons who have a long-term or recurring physical or mental impairment, which substantially limits their prospects of entry into, or advancement in employment
Price”	means an amount of money tendered for goods or services, and includes all applicable taxes less all unconditional discounts;
SMMEs”	means small businesses; as defined in section 1 of the National Small Business Act, 1996 (Act No 102 of 1996) a separate and distinct business entity, including co-operative enterprises and non-governmental organisations, managed by one owner or more which, including its branches or subsidiaries, if any, is

	predominantly carried on in any sector or sub sector of the economy mentioned in Column I of the Schedule and which can be classified as a micro-, a very small, a small or a medium enterprise by satisfying the criteria 40 mentioned in columns 3; 4 and 5 of the' Schedule opposite the smallest relevant size or class as mentioned in column 2 of the Schedule.
