1. INTRODUCTION

2. BACKGROUND ABOUT THE SACPCMP

The SACPCMP was established to regulate and promote specific Built Environment Management Professions and is a juristic person established by the Project and Construction Management Professions Act (Act No.48 of 2000) to provide for the registration of professionals in specified categories in the project and construction management professions; to provide for the regulation of the relationship between the SACPCMP and the Council for the Built Environment; and to provide for matters connected therewith.

- If candidates hold a Governance and/or Management position in either Recognised or non-recognised Voluntary Association(s) operating within the Council's registrable categories;
- Has an active Economic and/or Governance and/or Management interest in any of Councils' service providers (conflict of interest);
- Has active Governance and/or Management and/or Employee interest in any Institution/Organisation that is subject to Council's Regulatory functions jurisdiction.

- Sound analytical skills

- Strong leadership skills with ability to interact at Council and Executive level
