Details of the Position (requirements of position, qualification; registration etc)	<p>The purpose of the Project is to establish artisanal Installation, Repair and Maintenance (IRM) training hubs offering skills and business development services for entrepreneurs, micro enterprises and IRM trainees from targeted local communities.</p> <p>This tender concerns the appointment of an Implementation Consultant (IC) to support the NBI (Project Executing Agency) in the implementation of the program. The support to be provided by the IC comprises two parts i.e. development consultancy services and construction project management services. This implies the management of projects within the built environment from conception to completion, including management of related professional services.
